Call for Abstracts

THEME: Connecting the mixed methods community virtually during the pandemic

The Mixed Methods International Research Association - Caribbean Chapter (MMIRA-CC) in collaboration with the Caribbean Journal of Mixed Methods Research (CJMMR) and The University of the West Indies (UWI) School of Graduate Studies and Research is organizing an online symposium with a view to bringing scholars, educational practitioners, and students together to present their research and participate in workshops on mixed methods designs and analysis. Abstracts are invited which address, but are **not limited to** the following areas:

- Methodological innovations in MMR
- Impact of COVID-19 pandemic (on issues such as education, health, policy)
- Trending societal matters (relating to issues such as race, gender, social justice, violence)

The length of abstracts should not exceed 300 words. Abstracts should include:

- Presentation Title
- Presenter(s) Name(s) and Institutional Affiliation
- Abstract: Objective(s)/aim(s), method, findings/results, and conclusions
- Keywords

Work in Progress (WIP) are also welcome.

The deadline for the submission of abstracts is **December 2nd, 2020**. Submissions will be reviewed by a panel. Notification of acceptance of abstract will be sent by December 7, 2020. Please submit your abstract for consideration to mixedmethodsccc@gmail.com copied to conyefulu@utech.edu.jm.

Guidelines for accepted Abstracts:

In preparing your paper for presentation at the symposium be guided by the following:

1. Your presentation should be no longer than 10 minutes
2. Presentations may be prepared in the format of a PowerPoint or Poster presentation
3. The presentation should be delivered live on the day of the symposium
4. As a precaution should in case there are internet connectivity issues, we strongly recommend that you submit a pre-recorded version of the presentation by December 14, 2020 and provide us with the link – e.g. Google Drive or OneDrive – to access the presentation.
5. There will be time allotted at the end of the presentations in your breakout room to respond to questions and comments from other presenters and participants in the session. It is a great opportunity to network.
6. Please submit your pre-recorded presentation on or before December 14th, 2020
